Popash	<i>Fraxinus caroliniana</i>	Flowers	Partial Shade
Red Buckeye	<i>Aesculus pavia</i>	Flowers	Shade Tolerant
River Birch	<i>Betula nigra</i>	No Flowers	Partial Shade
Trident Maple	<i>Acer buergeranum</i>	Flowers	Partial Shade
Two Winged Silverbell	<i>Halesia diptera</i>	Flowers	Shade Tolerant

Fringe/Granny Graybeard	<i>Chionanthus virginicus</i>	Flowers	Shade Tolerant
Possumhaw	<i>Ilex decidua</i>	No Flowers	Shade Tolerant
Sparkleberry	<i>Vaccinium arboreum</i>	Flowers	Shade Tolerant
Witch-Hazel	<i>Hamamelis virginiana</i>	Flowers	Shade Tolerant
